House Arrest/GPS Monitoring is an **ALTERNATIVE TO JAIL!**

We electronically track the movement of offenders using a GPS tracking device worn on your ankle.

House Arrest is very similar to a work release program. You will be confined to your home unless you are allowed to work; and/or attend school. Any court ordered activities (court appearances, drug testing, PO meetings) will be allowed.

If drug testing is ordered by the court, there will be additional fees.

1. You must not break the law; this includes and is not limited to:
 - a. Use of illicit drugs and/or alcohol
 - b. Following all court orders (restraining orders, curfews, etc.)

2. **Make and keep weekly schedule**
 - a. You are allowed to leave your property **only** to approved locations
 - b. All schedules must be approved by staff *at least* one day prior to leaving your home
 - c. Deviations from schedules are violations of house arrest and may lead to your arrest

3. You will **wear** the tracking bracelet at all times and will not remove it for any reason

4. You will **charge** the bracelet with the charger provided no less than 2 solid hours every day

5. You will not submerge the bracelet in water (NO BATHS, POOLS, HOT TUBS, ETC.), showers are OK

6. You must **communicate** with Midwest Justice (phone calls, texts, bracelet paging)
 - a. Communication is the **KEY** to House Arrest
 - b. You are responsible for making sure Midwest Justice can get a hold of you at all times

7. You must report any perceived defects, damage or malfunctions of the equipment immediately
 - a. You will allow inspection of the assigned equipment upon request
 - b. You must return the equipment in good working order
 - c. You are required to physically return the House Arrest equipment on the day your House Arrest is completed

8. You will follow all requests given to you by your House Arrest Officer (meetings, court dates, drug testing, etc)

9. You are financially responsible for the care of the equipment. You will be held responsible for any damage, and prosecuted for its theft if not returned. Tampering with the House Arrest equipment is a Felony offense

10. **Clients must pay for our services.** The initial fee must be paid to begin House Arrest. If your sentence is longer than 7 days, **weekly payments must be made** to remain on House Arrest. A payment agreement will be signed before House Arrest can begin

11. Compliance with any Exclusion zones is a must; there is a zero tolerance to these violations

The Rules of House Arrest have been explained to me. I fully understand what is expected of me, and the consequences of my failure to comply with all program expectations.
